Do we know Jesus? Do we really understand what Jesus has done for us?

This story 'Road to Emmaus' is of two disciples who, after the death and resurrection of Jesus, walked seven miles from Jerusalem to their village of Emmaus. While they were walking, they were describing to each other of what an incredible week they just had! As another person joined them, they did not recognise that it was Jesus.

Although the disciples knew who Jesus was, they did not recognize Him as he walked beside them. They knew a lot about Him. They had been witnesses to all those things that had happened in Jerusalem. They had heard, no doubt, on many occasions the things Jesus had testified about Himself. Yet, they were not able to recognize Jesus when they met Him. After all the time they spent with Jesus, they still questioned if Jesus was real Son of God.

Jesus walked them through the whole Story to show who He was, why He had come, and why it was Important. Jesus wanted them to see that if they would only believe what the Scriptures say about Him, they would understand why He came and why He had to suffer. They would have known who He was. But also understand why he had to go through all the hardship and suffering. As they got to Emmaus, and as they were about to break bread, they saw it was Jesus.






PRAYER:

CRAFT: Walking with Jesus

What you need:

- Paper
- Pipe Cleaner
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hole Punch
- Markers or textures or pencils

1. Trace your foot or shoe on the paper



2. Cut the tracing out



3. Using the hole punch, punch 3 holes onto the cut-out tracing



4. Fold your pipe cleaner in half and thread it through the top hole. Twist the pipe cleaner on the back of the shoe then fold it down to secure



5. Now thread the 2 remaining ends of the pipe cleaner into the other 2 holes. Twist and fold to secure at the back of the shoe



6. Last step is to decorate the shoe and add your sentiment. For example: "Walk with Jesus"
